Tuition and Fees 2010 / 2011

Pre-Kindergarten	\$4,000.00 per year
Kindergarten	\$5,500.00 per year
Grades One through Twelve	\$7,500.00 per year
Application Fee (one time only)	\$ 100.00 per student
School Improvement Fee (one time only)	\$1,000.00 per family

Tuition payments must be arranged by the first day of school. Bank transfers or checks in US dollars are preferred. If necessary, quarterly payments can be arranged in the school office. Make US dollar checks payable to the International Academy of Suriname. Bank transfers should be made to:

Tuition Forms

By the beginning of the school year, each parent will be asked to complete a Tuition Form. This form outlines who will make the tuition payment and on what schedule the payment will be paid. Tuition may be paid by the year, the

semester, or the quarter. Some families may qualify for monthly payments. Under the quarter plan, one quarter of the tuition must be paid at the beginning of the school year and the subsequent quarterly payments at the end of each of the first three quarters in the school calendar. Report cards and transcripts will not be given to students whose tuition for the following quarter is not paid.

Tuition for Students Enrolled for Part of a Year or for Withdrawn Students

Tuition is calculated on a quarterly basis. Parents must pay tuition for any quarter in which they have children enrolled. Quarterly tuition is not reimbursed. However, a prorated refund will be given to any student withdrawing from IAS whose tuition was paid for the entire year. In other words, tuition will be refunded for the remaining quarters after a student withdraws. Tuition will not be refunded if the student is expelled or asked to withdraw.

Transfer and Exchange Fees

Some checks or wire transfers written in dollars from some banks incur a collection charge, which may be as high as \$100. These charges will be passed on to you. Exchange fees for Suriname dollar checks that we must deposit in our US account will be charged to the family's account.
